Christine paints in acrylics, oil and gouache, as well as drawing with pencil, ink and charcoal. She also enjoys silk-screen printing on textiles. Her subject matter is primarily landscape, seascape and still life, but drawing people and keeping a visual diary/art journal is an important part of her practice.

Christine said: As an art tutor, I aim to encourage each artist to find their own creative spark and style. My own work is characteristically colourful, with a fairly loose impressionistic style. I do not like the idea of 'rules' in art but do work from a base that includes realism, colour, tone and texture.

This term I would like to use colour as a focus as it is an important part of my work and contributes to the way a painting can be 'arresting' to the viewer. The use of harmonious and complementary tones as well as considering a dominance of either 'warm' or 'cool' tones in an artwork is an important element of art practice.

Materials list.

Paints - bring whatever you have, but prefer acrylics, water colour and gouache. If using oils - odourless solvent please!

Brushes - variety: e.g. wide and narrow square cut, round fine, filbert.

Pencils - 2B and softer. Water-soluble coloured pencils are useful.

Charcoal and other mark makers that you like to use.

Cartridge paper for rough sketching and testing colour mixes.

Good quality paper - 180 - 300 gsm at least A4 size.

Canvas - stretched or on board - useful to have a variety of sizes.

Note: It's not necessary to have everything on the list - this is a guide only.
