Jennifer is an emerging artist in the Northern Rivers, with a degree in visual arts and a skill for teaching. She loves to “challenge the boundaries” and works with paper, cardboard and natural objects to create 2D and 3D paintings, sculptures and installations. All her works have a significant meaning and she has exhibited at the Lismore Gallery and Northern Rivers Community Gallery. Jennifer is skilled in many mediums and likes to use the human form to help challenge the boundaries.

In our sessions, with the help of a model, she will help us interpret the human form with life drawing, which will challenge our perceptions. This will then extend into combining a range of mediums with drawing and collage, to create art works which are a little bit out of the ordinary.

You will need to bring for the first lesson: pencils, charcoal, lots of drawing paper, wet and dry media, pastels, paints, papers (eg. good cartridge 84 x60 size).

Please note the last session is without a tutor and our meeting is held at 12pm. The class is limited to 28 participants and your place is secured when payment is received.
